

"The enhanced threat posed by active shooters and the swiftness with which active shooter incidents unfold support the importance of preparation by law enforcement officers and citizens alike."



Empower your staff and protect students.

ALICE Training empowers staff and students to participate in their own survival using proactive options-based response strategies in the face of violence. When ALICE response strategies are implemented, unwilling participants in the violent critical incident are empowered to choose their best survival option. Seconds count during a violent event and the actions taken in between when the event begins, and law enforcement arrives, are significant and can increase survivability.
